- lunar** (*adjective*) of or having to do with the moon
- mimic** (*verb*) to copy or imitate by speech, gesture, or expression;  
(*noun*) a person who imitates other people
- odyssey** (*noun*) a long, adventurous journey
- parable** (*noun*) a simple story that teaches a moral lesson
- quake** (*noun*) a moment of trembling;  
(*verb*) to tremble

- rove** (*verb*) 1. to wander at random;  
2. to roam widely
- sanctify** (*verb*) 1. to set apart as holy;  
2. to purify or free from sin
- solemn** (*adjective*) serious; earnest
- subscribe** (*verb*) 1. to sign one's name;  
2. to agree with something
